



ARTS AND CRAFTS

Sidewalk Chalk Paint

This activity is best done outside.

Ingredients & Supplies:

1/2 c Water

1/2 C Cornstarch

Food Coloring

Recycled juice bottles (with lids) or

squeezable ketchup/mustard bottles

1/2"—1" paint brushes

Instructions:

1. Put water and cornstarch in your bottle. Seal with the lid and shake well, making sure all of the cornstarch is dissolved into the water.
2. Add the food coloring to the bottle a few drops at a time. Seal and shake well.
3. Continue to add drops to achieve the desired color.
4. Test the paint. If it is too runny, add a teaspoon of cornstarch and mix.
5. This paint can be used with a brush or thickened even more and squeezed from a ketchup or mustard bottle.

*Note: Use on a smooth surface, avoiding high traffic areas.
